Champagne Rosé

There are two ways of producing Pink Champagne, one process is called blended rosé, where still red wine and white wine are blended prior to the Champagne becoming fizzy, this allows a better control over the color of the Champagne, the shade of pink being the trademark of houses, the other process is called Bleeding Rosé, in this process the still wine used to produce the Champagne is already pink in color and went through a "maceration process" where the skin of the red grapes, colors the juice.

Gewürztraminer - Treasured for its intense floral aromas, Gewürztraminer has thrived for centuries around Germany. Quality examples are ageworthy, but most are best enjoyed in their youth to preserve acidity. The sweet floral aromatics and ginger-like spice paired with its fuller body make Gewürztraminer a great partner to Indian and Creole Cuisine.

Riesling - An aromatic white variety that can produce white wines ranging in style from bone-dry to very sweet. Germany is the world's most important producer of Riesling. Off-dry Riesling wines make a great pairing to spicy Indian, Asian & Creole cuisines and do excellently alongside duck, pork, bacon, shrimp and crab.

Merlot


