CHAMPAGNE

BY THE GLASS

N.V France / Champagne / Bollinger “Special Cuvée Brut” USD 19.00
60% Pinot Noir / 25% Chardonnay / 15% Meunier
Special cuvée is the result of a precise blend of several harvests but above all of reserve wines that give it all its structure and make it a reference of the Bollinger style.

WHITE WINE

2022 New Zealand / Marlborough USD 9.00
Mussel Bay (Sauvignon Blanc)
An intensely gooseberry & citrus nose, with hints of freshly torn basil leaves. Clean, crisp palate with ripe tropical fruits and a well-balanced acidity.

2022 Germany / Baden USD 12.00
Schieferkopf “Troken sec” (Riesling)
Light yellow with golden tints, the nose is fruity and floral. Citrus, Mirabelle-Plum & Orange Blossom notes. Mineral structure.

2022 France / Burgundy / Petit Chablis USD 15.00
Louis Jadot (Chardonnay)
A white that offers citrus aromas mixed with touches of flint & minerals & subtle fresh herbs. On the palate it reveals a good freshness that combines pear & citrus flavors, mineral infusions, dry & crisp finishes & an aftertaste that brings back all the flavors from the first sip.

ROSE WINE

2021 France / Cotes de Provence USD 12.00
Marie Christine “Cru Classé” (Grenache, Cinsault, Syrah)
This wine has a soft pink powdered hue. The nose is fruity, fine and delicate with exotic fruits notes. On the palate, the attack is marked red fruits notes with a rich aromatic complexity.

RED WINE

2018 Portugal / Douro USD 9.00
Ramos Pinto “Duas Quintas” (Touriga Nacional, Touriga Franca)
Aroma of plum & cherry, concentrated & complex. A dense wine, with velvety tannins, yet also fresh. Rich & Full bodied with a silky-smooth finish.

2021 New Zealand / Marlborough USD 12.00
Te Pa, Pa Road (Pinot Noir)
On the nose this wine displays dark raspberry & plums, with hints of dried herbs & mocha. The dark berry fruits carry through the palate. The tannins are soft & velvety, supported by the use of subtle oak. Bright aromatic intensity with notes of ripe red cherry, plum, sage & thyme. A pure varietal expression on the palate with the medium weight red fruit balanced with acidity & fine tannins that have a delicious dry finish.

2014 France / Bordeaux / Medoc USD 14.00
Chateau Escot “Cru Bourgeois” (Merlot & Cabernet Sauvignon)
Soft, velvet taste to the palate and it with its roundness, it wraps the sharper edges of other wines that it is paired with. This sensory experience is completed with the smell of red and black fruit, as well as delicate tones of red flowers.

N.V France. Champagne, Billecart-Salmon "Brut Reserve" (375 ml) USD 90.00
40% Pinot Meunier / 30% Chardonnay / 30% Pinot Noir

Balance & harmony combine together in this light & subtle champagne. Its blend is made up of Pinot Noir, Chardonnay & Meunier sourced from the very best sites of the Champagne region.

N.V France. Champagne, Taittinger "Brut La Francaise" (375 ml) USD 100.00
40% Chardonnay / 60% Pinot Noir

A brilliant pale gold in the glass, the wine delivers a complex mixture of clean stone fruit with subtle notes of spice & floral characteristics to the nose & palate.

N.V France. Champagne, Pol Roger "Brut Reserve" (375 ml) USD 110.00
40% Pinot Noir / 40% Pinot Meunier / 20% Chardonnay

The Pinot Noir (bringing structure, body & power) is mainly produced from some of the best crus of the Montagne de Reims. The Pinot Meunier (ensuring freshness, roundness & fruitiness) is issued from several crus from the Vallée de la Marne & from the Epernay area. The Chardonnay (adding its aromatic complexity, finesse, elegance & lightness) comes from Epernay & some of the best crus of the Côte des Blancs.

ROSE CHAMPAGNE

N.V France. Champagne, Bollinger Rose USD 190.00
Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier

Very well structured, with exemplary purity of red fruits. A striking Champagne on the nose offering similar sensations on the palate. Generous & satiny, lightly spiced with balanced hints of stoned fruits thanks to a lovely freshness in the finish.

N.V France. Champagne, Taittinger "Prestige Rose" USD 230.00
30% of Chardonnay / 45% of Pinot Noir / 25% of Pinot Meunier

Intense cherry-pink in color with extremely fine, persistent pinpoint bubbles rising in delicate strands to the surface of the wine. Its classic, aromatic Pinot fragrance of red raspberries & strawberries are offset by elegant, subtle floral & earth nuances. On the palate, the ripe, full berry flavors are vibrant yet refined, delicately balanced by a fresh acidity which carries into a crisp, refreshing finish of persistent length.

N.V France. Champagne, Billecart Salmon "Brut Rose" USD 250.00
30% of Chardonnay / 45% of Pinot Noir / 25% of Pinot Meunier

- N.V France. Champagne Bollinger “Special Cuvee brut” USD 120.00
60% Pinot Noir / 25% Chardonnay / 15% Meunier
Freshness & fruit aromas. The Chardonnay offers a delicacy underscored by aromas of yellow fruit such as peach & Mirabel plum. On the palate the Pinot Noir from Aÿ has a magnificent structure. Hawthorn & white blossom intertwine harmoniously, with a finely-honed acidity carried by notes of citrus.
- N.V France. Taittinger “Brut Reserve” USD 140.00
40% Chardonnay / 35% Pinot Noir / 25% Pinot Meunier
A unique among fine non-vintage champagne, and a minimum ageing of three years in the cellars, where it reaches the peak of aromatic maturity, makes the “Brut Réserve” a delicately balanced champagne.
- N.V France. Champagne, Billecart-Salmon “Brut Reserve” USD 160.00
Chardonnay / Pinot Meunier / Pinot Noir
It is a delicate, harmonious non-vintage Champagne, with an expression of floral freshness. Reconnaissable by the finesse of its slow rising bubbles and fresh fruit flavours, this Champagne is ideal for every occasion and can be enjoyed with a wide variety of dishes.
- N.V France. Champagne, Henriot “Brut Souverain” USD 160.00
45% Pinot Noir / 40% Chardonnay / 15% Pinot Meunier
Each cru expresses itself in a unique & dynamic manner, not overshadowing the others in the expression. Therefore, it is a perfectly organized “ballet of aromas”: generous & salivating notes of cake with fresh citrus fruits, the exuberance of smoke evolving into pure chalk, not forgetting to mention the basket of stone fruits & red fruits. The aromatic notes of Henriot Brut Souverain have an infinite number of complexities due to its diverse crus.
- N.V France. Champagne, Louis Roederer “Collection 242” USD 180.00
Collection 242 represents the Champagne House’s 242nd blend since its foundation. It is crafted from 34% Perpetual Reserve, 10% oak-aged reserve wines from the 2009, 2011, 2013, 2014, 2015 & 2016 vintages, complemented by 56% of the finest wines from the 2017 harvest: mainly Chardonnays & Pinot noirs & Meuniers from the Vallée de la Marne.
- N.V France. Champagne, Taittinger “Nocturne” USD 200.00
60% Pinot Noir / 40% Chardonnay
It is the result of several harvests undertaken when the fruit had reached perfect maturity. The uniqueness of its mix and its long maturation period in the cellars gives it its fullness and smoothness. It works well as an accompaniment to dessert, or simply as a digestif on its own after a meal.
- 2012 France. Champagne Bollinger “La Grande Annee” USD 250.00
65% Pinot Noir / 35% Chardonnay
The delicate color and golden hues are a sign of the wine’s maturity and reflective of Bollinger’s wine-making methods. Full and expressive on the nose. Apricot, almond and hazelnut, as well as honey and cereals, intertwine in a symphony of aromas. Dense, satiny and long on the palate. It is fresh and unctuous, with a deliciously bitter finish. The texture and structure are exceptional.

Madame Bollinger’s great idea was to choose an old vintage, recently disgorged and dosed like an Extra Brut. The recent disgorgement guarantees the remarkable freshness of the wine. Bodega Norton "Finca La Colonia"
Golden yellow color with greenish hues. Perceived in the nose scents of green apples and tropical fruits. It has good structure on the palate, round and balanced with a delicate finish.
- 2021 Australia / South Australia USD 40.00
Oxford Landing Estates
Aromas of yellow peach & ripe nectarine with accents of wild honey & hints of lemon myrtle, supported by freshly cut hay & cinnamon spice. The palate shows the slightest hint of oak as cinnamon & spice, highlighting the complexity derived from barrel matured reserve wine. Balanced acidity gives the wine thrust through to the refreshing finish.
- 2021 Australia / South of Australia USD 45.00
De Bartoli, Family Selection
Pale yellow in the glass it's made to be drunk young & fresh. Hints of pear & stone fruits, alongside a dash of buttery oak are well balanced on the palate. It's soft & easy & perfect as a mid-week quaffed.
- 2022 France / Languedoc USD 50.00
V.D.P D'Oc, Moulin de Gassac
Floral and aromatic, Moulin de Gassac Chardonnay is a white wine that, despite its modest denomination and location, beautifully reveals all the aromas of the leading Chardonnay grape variety.
- 2017 U.S.A / California USD 70.00
Gnarly Head
From specially selected vineyards in Lodi & Monterey. Chardonnay fruit from the Lodi region contributes ripe, rich fruit flavors with a full mouthfeel, while grapes from Monterey add crisp acidity, balanced with vibrant citrus & abundant tropical flavors.
- 2018 France / Burgundy / Pouilly-Fuisse USD 90.00
Domaine Bouchard Pere & Fils
Delicate bouquet with fruit & floral notes. A very perfumed, silky & elegant wine.
- 2021 Argentina / Mendoza Valley USD 110.00
Kaiken "Ultra"
Tropical fruits, and corozo fruit, such as peaches. Citrus notes and a delicate and elegant scent of vanilla. Complex, fresh and vivacious. Balanced and refreshing natural acidity. Persistent finish. Great volume and creaminess, yet soft and elegant.

Domaine Michel Juillot
There is evident minerality and I very much like the mouth feel of the balanced, focused, detailed and impressively persistent finish. The tannic spine is firm but already well-integrated.

Bodega Norton "Finca La Colonia"
Intense aromas of citrus, herbs and pink grapefruit. Fresh, fruity palate with an elegant dry finish.
- 2022 New Zealand / Marlborough / Sauvignon Blanc USD 40.00
Mussel Bay
It's a vegetal style led by notes of jalapeño, bell pepper, snap pea and grass backed by a waxy citrus character. The chalky palate is edgy and crisp.
- 2021 Italy / Umbria / Pinot Grigio USD 45.00
Santa Cristina by Antinori
Santa Cristina Pinot Grigio has fruity aromas of pineapple & green apple along with hints of orange zest. It is a balanced, soft, savory & pleasant wine.

This wine delivers aromatics of nectarine, lime, florals & hints of toasted spice. The palate is concentrated & precise, with citrus, black currant, fresh herbs & grilled pineapple flavors. This wine possesses crisp, refreshing acidity & a touch of chalky minerality.
- 2021 New Zealand / Martinborough / Sauvignon Blanc USD 80.00
Craggy Range, Family Collection, Te Muna
Typical aromas of passionfruit pulp interwoven with kaffir lime leaf. The palate has the textural elements we have come to love in this vineyard, with succulence & sophistication. The finish is almost saline & leaves the drinker reaching for the second glass.

RIESLING

- 2020 Australia / South Australia USD 50.00
Yalumba "Y" Series (Dry)
From the German side of the Rhine basin, planted on granitic soil with sandy top soil. Wild cherries & orange blossom dominate the nose. A taut palate displaying mineral structure, roundness & a superb, long finish.
- 2022 Germany / Baden USD 60.00
Schieferkopf "Troken sec"
Light yellow with golden tints, the nose is fruity and floral. Citrus, Mirabelle-Plum & Orange Blossom notes. Mineral structure.
- 2022 Australia / South Australia / Eden Valley USD 80.00
Pewsey Valley (Dry)
Pale straw with green hues. Intense aromas of fine dried herbs, white flowers, lemon & lime. A long & rich palate, reminiscent of grapefruit, lime & fresh rosemary. The wine finishes with soft natural acidity, which balances the flavor & minerality.
- 2017 France / Alsace USD 100.00
Domaine Trimbach (Riesling)
Its delicate bouquet, the beautiful balance between its dry character, its distinguished fruitiness & its natural liveliness contribute to its exceptional richness. As required by the style of the house, it is vinified in a dry, straight, precise style.

CHENIN BLANC

- 2018 South Africa / Stellenbosch USD 45.00
Winery of Good Hope
These grapes are grown in the Heidelberg area on decomposed granite soils where they benefit from the cooling breezes of the ocean, which moderate the hot climate. Bush Vine Chenin Blanc grapes were picked at different levels of ripeness, to build good acidity, fruit, & depth.
- 2021 South Africa / Stellenbosch USD 60.00
L'Avenir
A crisp & delicate expression of Stellenbosch Chenin Blanc. This blend of French oak matured & unwooded Chenin Blanc from old vineyards presents a fine balance of natural acidity, generous fruit & a touch of roasted almonds.
- 2021 South Africa / Darling USD 70.00
Fairview, La Capra
Chenin Blanc is a treasure that has become more fashionable in recent years. Inviting aromas of tropical fruit salad (guava, pineapple) on the nose. Flavors of stone fruit & citrus with a soft, smooth texture & balanced acidity.
- 2020 South Africa / Stellenbosch USD 90.00
Radford Dale "The Renaissance of Chenin Blanc"
Through profound understanding of this vineyard, rather than manipulating the wine, we have been able to create a wine that reflects its site through freshness, elegance, finesse and purity.

- 2021 Australia / Victoria USD 40.00
Woolshed (Moscato)
Sweet tropical fruit, crisp green apple & hints of musk. Aromatic, light & fruity with a natural spritz & refreshing finish.
- 2019 Portugal / Douro USD 50.00
Ramos Pinto, Duas Quintas (Viozinho / Rabigato / Arinto)
Intense & concentrated. Full, wide mouth with acidity & soft texture. Citric & ripe fruit aromas. Fresh & long.
- 2018 Australia / McLaren Valley USD 60.00
D'Arenberg, The hermit Crab (Viognier / Marsanne)
Dry, lush, rich & silky smooth on the palate with white florals, tropical fruit, fresh pineapple, melon, white-fleshed stone fruit, ginger spice, lemon curd & minerally flavors long & elegant on the palate. Very complex.
- 2021 France / Corsica USD 70.00
Clos Columbu, Tribbiera (Vermentino)
The dress is crystalline with straw reflections. The nose is floral & delicate with notes of iris, rose & orange peel. The mouth is held in length by salinity.
- 2016 France / Rhone Valley / Crozes Hermitage USD 80.00
Domaine Etienne Guigal (95% Marsanne / 5% Roussanne)
Golden yellow. Aromas of white flowers such as hawthorn blossom & acacia. Delicate oak. Fine & elegant. Full body, round & rich. Remarkable freshness with all the finesse & richness of the appellation.
- 2017 Italy / Toscana USD 100.00
Gaja, Aja Camarcand Vistamare (Viognier / Vermentino)
Intense floral notes of acacia & linden flowers. The refreshing presence of Fiano gives notes of fern, musk & menthol. On the palate, it is fresh & compact with notes of bergamot, pear, nectarine & white currant. Then it shifts toward a more mineral & spicy character, with notes of flint, rosemary, saffron. The wine gets riper in the finish with hints of mango, almond & fig leaves.
- 2020 France / Rhone Valley / Chateauneuf du Pape USD 150.00
Domaine du Vieux Telegraphe "La Crau" (40% Clairette / 25% Grenache blanc / 25% Roussane / 10% Bourboulenc.)
A member of the classic school of white Châteauneuf-du-Pape: more floral than fruity aromas & characterized by balance & freshness. It might dip in form between four & eight years, but the best vintages age as well as the reds.

SANGIOVESE / MERLOT / CABERNET

- 2018 Italy / Toscana USD 50.00
Col Di Sasso (Sangiovese / Cabernet)
Black cherries & spice. Rich with soft tannins, delivering persistent black-fruit flavors & subtle hints of smoke, with a lingering finish.
- 2020 Australia / South Australia USD 60.00
Yalumba “Y Series” (Cabernet Sauvignon)
Enticing berry fruit, dewy eucalypt, briar & spicy oak aromas are the perfect opening. The palate builds slowly with black fruits & spice; rich & full, mouth coating cocoa tannins & blackcurrants. The wine has lovely length; the structure is restrained & seamless. This is a Cabernet that is contemporary, enjoyable & varietal.
- 2014 France / Bordeaux / Medoc USD 70.00
Chateau Escot “Cru Bourgeois” (Merlot & Cabernet Sauvignon)
Soft, velvet taste to the palate and it with its roundness, it wraps the sharper edges of other wines that it is paired with. This sensory experience is completed with the smell of red and black fruit, as well as delicate tones of red flowers.
- 2016 France / Bordeaux USD 70.00
Château Pavie “Esprit de Pavie” (Merlot & Cabernet franc)
The aromas are in perfect harmony with the depth of the colour: crème de cassis, sweet blackberry, beautiful aromatic diversity on the nose, lively and dashing. The woodiness delicately emphasizes the whole.
- 2015 France / Bordeaux / Haut – Medoc USD 80.00
Chateau de Camensac “Second de Camensac” (Merlot & Cabernet Sauvignon)
Benefiting from the same care as Château de Camensac, it is blended from carefully selected batches, specifically for the second wine, in accordance with its identity. Soft tannins, ripe fruit & elegance.
- 2014 France / Bordeaux / Saint Emilion Grand Cru USD 80.00
Chateau Haut Saint Brice (60% Merlot / 40% Cabernet)
The wine comes with a very dark purple color shot through with violet. The nose is dominated by aromas of ripe, almost jammy fruit. On the palate, the medium-bodied fruitiness comes through with smooth, well integrated tannins, leading to a long, harmonious & remarkably fine finish.
- 2018 South Africa / Stellenboch / Winery Road USD 100.00
Ken Forrester Vineyard “Reserve”, Pat’s Garden
This wine is characterized by an intense ruby color with hints of garnet & a complex bouquet of ripe black fruit, dark chocolate, & spices. On the palate, it is a full-bodied wine with a smooth & velvety texture, exhibiting blackcurrant, plum, & cherry flavors complemented by subtle oak notes & a long & satisfying finish.

- 2015 France / Bordeaux / Pomerol USD 120.00
Chateau Grange Neuve (Merlot / Cabernet)
It is an exceptional wine with a full-bodied flavor, rich texture, & a long finish. This wine is produced from a traditional blend of Merlot & Cabernet Franc grapes grown in the gravelly & clay soil of the prestigious Pomerol appellation. The vines are carefully tended to by the winemakers, who follow sustainable & natural farming practices that respect the environment.
- 2018 Australia / South Australia / Coonawara USD 140.00
Yalumba “The Cigar” (Cabernet Sauvignon)
The aromatic is opulent, with the perfume of violets, dark soy, hints of spice & the warm, comforting mélange of black fruits. The palate is eloquent with blackcurrants, red plums, & clove spice melding with dark chocolate.
- 2016 Bordeaux / Bordeaux / Margaux USD 160.00
Chateau Ferriere, Les Remparts de Ferriere (60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 40% Merlot)
A nice nose with a mix of fresh fruits, blossom notes & spices. A very beautiful clarity of the fruit. On the palate, the tannins are smooths & round. A nice balance between freshness, fruitiness & the silkiness of the structure. The wine is both elegant & dense. A very beautiful complexity & a nice length.
- 2016 Italy / Tuscany USD 180.00
Gaja, Camarcanda Magari Bolgheri (Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc)
Deep ruby red with violet hues. The Cabernet varieties show their muscles with dark small fruits like black currant, Marasca cherry & blackberry. 2020 Magari shows a complex character without being brash. The nose is rich, it starts fresh & then develops into Mediterranean scrub & black tea notes. The palate is voluminous with fine-grained & silky tannins. This wine has a long-lasting & a very flavorful finish.
- 2014 France / Bordeaux / Saint-Julien USD 180.00
Sarget de Gruaud Larose.
Château Gruaud Larose gives us access here with its Sarget cuvée to a second wine of very good quality. A dense body of black fruits dances around an elegant oakiness & robust but already well-polished tannins. A beautiful floral imprint also marks this cuvée giving a nice complexity to the whole.
- 2019 U.S.A / California USD 220.00
The Prisoner (Cabernet Sauvignon)
Aromas of black cherry & ripe plum are layered with vanilla & baking spice. Concentrated dark fruit flavors culminate in a lush, full mouthfeel & a lengthy finish.
- 2015 Australia / Clare Valley USD 250.00
Jim Barry, “The Berbournie” (Cabernet Sauvignon)
Deep berry compote & spicy oak combine with hints of musk & wet rock on the nose. A plush & velvet like entry on the palate. Spice, & a wave of wet stone, flow into ripe opulent fruit & a hint of forest floor flavours. An abundance of supple tannins & dark chocolate to finish.

PINOT NOIR / PINOTAGE / ZINFANDEL

- 2019 France / Burgundy / Chenas USD 60.00
Domaine Piron "Quartz"
Named after veins of quartz that run through the granite soil, this wine is ripe and generous. Wood aged and perfumed, the wine has touches of tannin and smoky black fruits.
- 2019 France / Brugundy / Beaujolais USD 70.00
