Kalutara Bodhiya

2.5 hours | USD 25 per person

Located at the southern end of the 38m Kalutara Bridge, the three-storey Kalutara Bodhiya Temple was built in the 1960s, and holds the distinction of being the only stupa in the world that is hollow, and has inside access.

Richmond Castle

2.5 hours | USD 25 per person

Built at the turn of the century in Kalutara, Richmond Castle is considered to be one of the most spectacular architectural works of the period. Formerly the property of a wealthy landowner turned philanthropist, the mansion stands majestically atop a hill, on a 42-acre estate. Once a circuit bungalow for high-ranking officers of the British administrative service, today it is a popular tourist attraction, and serves as an educational centre for underprivileged children in Kalutara.



Thudugala Ella Waterfall

4 hours | USD 35 per person

Situated on a former plantation owned during the British occupation, this waterfall is a natural stream pool surrounded by a forest reserve. Though shorter than other waterfalls in Sri Lanka, the nearby forest reserve is home to beautiful migratory birds such as the Pale Bellied Flower Pecker — the smallest bird in Sri Lanka.



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
