# WHITE WATER RAFTING

The Zambezi River below the Victoria Falls is widely considered to be the very best White Water Rafting river in the world. With its deep channels and high-water volumes, the Zambezi has adrenaline-packed class 3 – 5 rapids interspersed with-tranquil pools. Rafters have the chance to enjoy the magnificent beauty of the Batoka Gorge between rafting the most exciting and challenging rapids on the planet with White Water Rafting Victoria Falls.

Rafting trips on offer vary from a couple of hours, to an incredible five-night, six-day excursion from the Victoria Falls all the way to Lake Kariba. After rafting, to avoid the strenuous climb out of the Gorge, the best way to get out of the Gorge is by helicopter. The flight takes just 15 minutes and includes an exhilarating flight through the Batoka Gorge and over the Victoria Falls before landing; a wonderfully exciting finish to a great Zambezi adventure.

All rafting excursions are dependent on river levels, during the highest water levels in April and May, rafting activities are usually closed. The multi-day rafting excursions are available in the low water season, however, depending on water levels, trips may be done by request in the high-water season too.

# WHITE WATER RAFTING VICTORIA FALLS RIVER EXCURSIONS
